

Schaller-Crestland Board of Education  
Regular Meeting

The Schaller-Crestland Board of Education met on Monday August 8, 2016 in the Schaller-Crestland Elem. Library. Present were; Trevor Toft, Alan Movall, Mike Schmitt, Tim DeLance, Kory Blum, Prin. Jarod Mozer, Supt. Jon Wiebers and Bd. Sec'y. Julie McClintic. Also present were Jenny Bailey from the Schaller Herald, Bethany Jones from the Ida County Courier and Alberto Najera. Also present were the Galva-Holstein Board members, Prin.'s Warnke and Richard and Bd. Sec'y. Cindy Dittmer.

Pres. Movall brought the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m.

Motion by Blum, seconded by Toft to approve the amended agenda (including approve sealed bid) as presented. Motion carried 5-0.

Alberto Najera addressed the boards regarding student discipline.

Motion by Toft, seconded by DeLance to approve the minutes of the July 11<sup>th</sup> board meeting. All ayes, motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Schmitt, seconded by DeLance to approve payment of the following district bills: general fund \$157,116.19, activity fund \$361.50, capital projects \$6511.69, hot lunch fund \$3481.76, daycare fund \$285.86, PPEL fund \$70,954.26. Motion carried 5-0.

Board secretary McClintic briefly went over the July financial report.

Prin.'s Mozer, Warnke and Richard each spoke a bit about how the summer has gone and the start of school.

Motion by Toft, seconded by Blum to accept the resignations of Travis Hoepfner, Shea Ryen and Anglea Rohlf. All ayes, motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Toft, seconded by Schmitt to offer a contract to Brita Baumann for \$9.00 an hour for an educational aide. All ayes, motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Schmitt, seconded by Blum to offer a contract for \$2500 to Jarod Mozer for the Middle School Activities Director. All ayes, motion carried 5-0.

Supt. Wiebers recommended the board offer a contract to Ali Swanson for a daycare position. Motion by Blum, seconded by Toft to offer a contract to Ali Swanson for \$7.75 (after 90 day review \$8.00) an hour for the Wee Wildcat Daycare. All ayes, motion carried 5-0.

Motion by DeLance, seconded by Schmitt to approve the following shared positions with Galva-Holstein CSD for the 2016-2017 school year:

Principal, Sec. Principal and Level 2 Investigator-Superintendent – Homeless Liason-Susan Kalin – Abuse of Students by School District Employees-Level I Investigator-School Nurse; Level I Alternate Abuse Invest. Elem. Principal and Sec. Principal – Level 2 Abuse Investigator-Sac Co. Sheriff's Dept. – Harassment – Elem. Principal and Elem. Guidance. All ayes, motion carried 5-0.

Shelly Pospeshil submitted a sealed bid for the old scoreboard that came out of the Schaller gymnasium. Motion by Toft, seconded by Blum to accept Shelly Pospeshil's bid of \$401 for the scoreboard All ayes, motion carried 5-0.
