

Schaller-Crestland Board of Education  
Regular Meeting

The Schaller-Crestland Board of Education met on Monday, Sept. 12, 2016 in the High School Media Center in Holstein. Present were; Alan Movall, Tim DeLance, Trevor Toft, Mike Schmitt, Kory Blum, Prin. Mozer, Supt. Wiebers and Bd. Sec'y. McClintic. Also present were the Galva-Holstein Board and Administration and Bethany Jones from the Chronilce.

Pres. Movall brought the meeting to order at 7:08 p.m.

Motion by DeLance, seconded by Toft to approve the agenda. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Blum, seconded by DeLance to approve the minutes of the August 8<sup>th</sup> board meeting. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Schmitt, seconded by Toft to approve payment of the following district bills: general fund \$33,174.22, activity fund \$841.95, Capital projects fund \$52,870.65, hot lunch fund \$11,220.58, management fund \$8852.25, daycare fund \$2359.00, and PPEL fund \$12,732.58. Motion carried 5-0.

Board Secretary McClintic went over the August financial report.

Supt. Wiebers shared two letters he received from the Iowa High School Athletic Association.

The Principal's each presented information.

Motion by Blum, seconded by Schmitt to accept the resignation of Lisa Meusburger as an educational aide. Motion carried 5-0.

Supt. Wiebers recommended the board approve each of the following positions:

Motion by Toft, seconded by DeLance to offer contracts to Dina Mitchell and Chancey Wilcke for Middle School Volleyball, each receiving \$2037. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Toft, seconded by DeLance to offer a contract from Schedule B to Dennis Freking for M.S. Vocal Instructor, paying \$1455.00. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Schmitt, seconded by Blum to offer a contract to Brian Hoepfner for Middle School Football, paying \$2037. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Toft, seconded by Schmitt to offer daycare contracts to Amanda Urban and Jesse Grazier, each receiving \$7.75 per hour and after 90 days \$8.00 per hour. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by DeLance, seconded by Toft to offer contracts to Dawn Faist and Krissy Bendixen for educational aides at \$9.00 per hour. Motion carried 5-0.

This being left off of last month's motion, Supt. Wiebers recommended the board approve the sharing of Clay Drenth with Galva-Holstein CSD, for the FFA program. Motion by Blum, seconded by Toft to approve Clay Drenth as a shared teacher with the Galva-Holstein CSD for the FFA program. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Toft, seconded by DeLance to approve Jessica Christensen as the Teacher Leadership (TLC) model teacher. Motion carried 5-0.

Supt. Wiebers informed the board the boiler in the Schaller building needs some repair work done to it. Since he hadn't received a bid for this yet, he recommended the board approve up to \$28,000 for the repair work. Motion by Blum, seconded by Schmitt to approve Supt. Wiebers recommendation and approve up to \$28,000 for boiler repairs. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Toft, seconded by DeLance to appoint Kory Blum as the Delegate Assembly representative. Motion carried 5-0.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Toft and seconded by DeLance to adjourn the meeting at 8:26 p.m. Carried.
