Qualifications and Procedures

1. Five scholarships a year will be awarded.
2. Each scholarship will be equal to the net income by the trust divided by five.
3. The applicant must be a high school graduating senior.
4. Each scholarship is granted for a period of one year.
5. Selection of the recipient shall be made without regard to race, color, religion, sex, or place of residence of the beneficiary.
6. The applicant shall submit the completed scholarship application to the guidance office by April 1.
