

## **Roger and Rosemary Clausen Fine Arts Scholarship**

Roger and Rosemary Clausen have established scholarships for deserving graduating seniors of the Galva-Holstein School District/Ridge View who are pursuing a degree at a post-secondary accredited educational institution. The specifics for the scholarship shall include the following:

1. The scholarship shall be available to the recipient for up to four (4) years.
2. The student to receive the scholarship each year shall be chosen by the Executive Committee of the Galva-Holstein Community School District Foundation.
3. The scholarship shall be in the amount of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) per year, per recipient, not to exceed four (4) years.
4. In determining which student shall receive/be awarded any scholarship, in addition to the pursuit of a fine arts degree, the following factors shall be taken into consideration:
  - a. preference shall be given to a qualified student pursuing a “fine arts” degree; however, it shall not be a requirement;
  - b. need of the student;
  - c. citizenship of the student;
  - d. academic achievement of the student; and
  - e. general character of the student.

However, no one thing shall be controlling, nor shall one thing be considered essential before a scholarship is awarded.

5. The fact that any student may be receiving another scholarship shall not prevent him or her from receiving the scholarship referred to herein. The students shall be required to make an application for any scholarship by completing an application form and submit one letter of recommendation. Applications shall be accepted and considered from all Galva-Holstein School District/Ridge View High School Seniors. No family member of the Foundation or the Executive Committee shall be eligible for the scholarship.

6. Once a scholarship has been awarded, the recipient shall be entitled to the same Two Thousand Dollar (\$2,000.00) scholarship for four (4) consecutive years. All funds awarded shall be paid directly to the institution of higher learning attended by the scholarship recipient. The scholarship recipient will be required to verify, on an annual basis, their eligibility to receive the scholarship by providing the Executive Committee with a verified copy of their transcripts showing that they are enrolled in an accredited educational institution as a student in good standing.
7. Deadline: April 1, 2019. Please turn application into Mrs. Todd in the guidance office.
